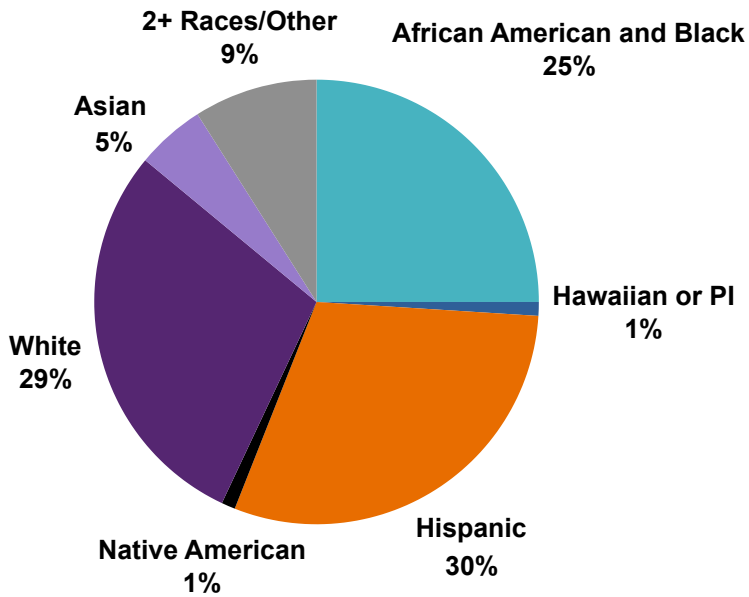

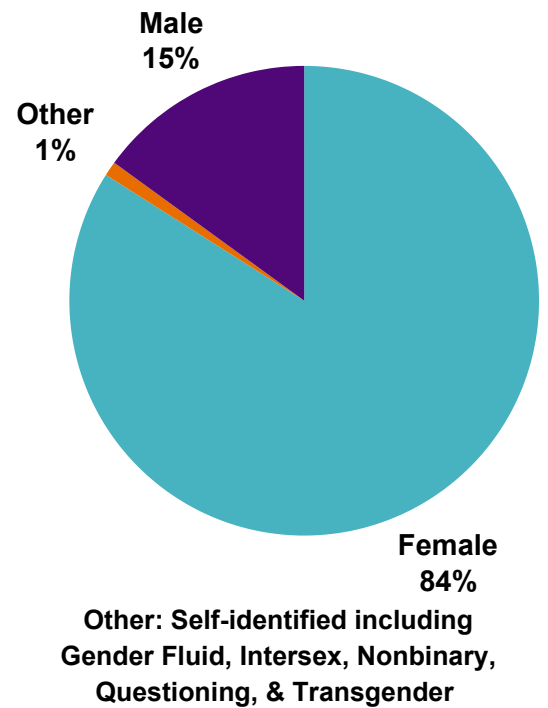

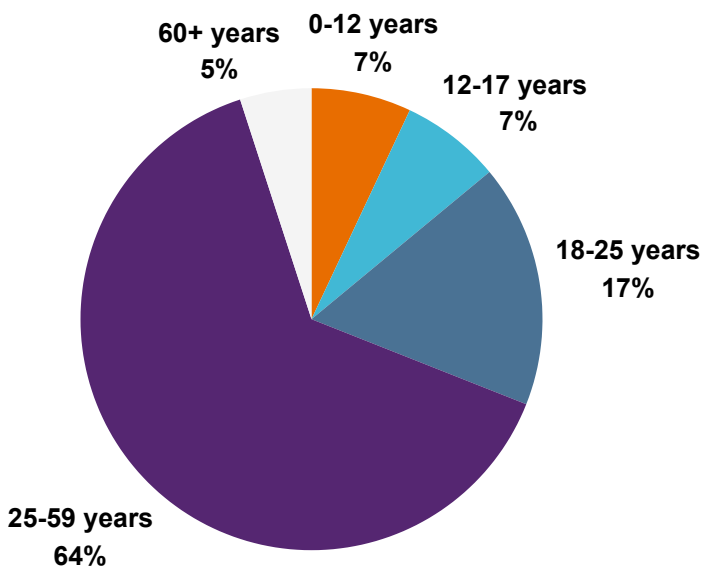
### Race & Ethnicity



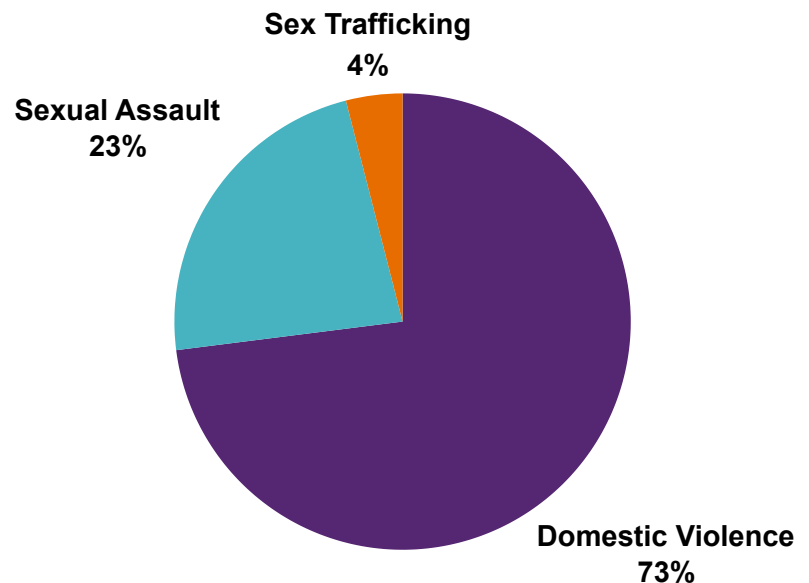
### Gender & Gender Identity
